Fort Meyers Information

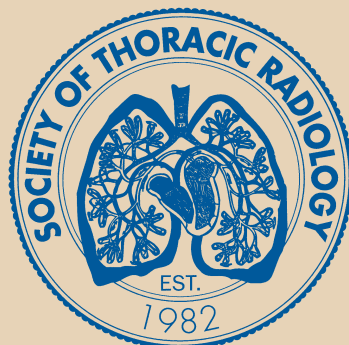
